



Key information;


- St Helen's Square is the 3rd largest open public space in the City of London.
- It reopened with a new contemporary design in 2018.
- It has been transformed into a colourful and welcoming place where office workers and visitors can meet or relax and enjoy the unique surrounding buildings.
- There are curved stone seating areas and colourful plants that create spaces within the square for people to sit and enjoy it.
- It acts as a major route for people to easily walk between the important office buildings e.g. 'The Gherkin' and The Lloyds building.
- The square flows into the outdoor covered space under 'The Cheesegrater'.
- The old church, St Andrew
 Undershaft is named after the
 giant maypole (known as a shaft
 in medieval times) that used to
 stand next to it. The wooden pole
 was used in festivals and people
 danced around it.

1. CONTEXT



THE LOCATION YOUR SCULPTURE WILL GO IN IS IMPORTANT...

So you will need to think about:

- What is nearby the location? e.g. buildings, trees or benches
- Is the location open or hidden? e.g. can it be seen from other areas of the Square?
- Is the area sheltered from rain or wind?



So you will need to think about:


- The size of the sculpture in relation to what is nearby.



So you will need to think about:


- What your sculpture made from.


4. FORM
